

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What is the Holy Convocation?

According to God's Word (Lev. 23:1-44) Holy Convocation is a gathering of the Lord's people to have a rich spiritual fellowship with the Lord and with one another. It is a time to renew our dedication to the Lord and to meditate upon His living word.

2. Do I have to stay the whole time?

On the basis of the Lord's word we encourage you to take complete leave from your work and stay the whole time to get the full blessings of the Lord. We request everyone to attend all meetings and to avoid all excursions/sight-seeing trips to either before or after the completion of the meetings.

3. How will I be accommodated?

If you are a family/group of 4 or more you will be given a single room. All others will be allotted shared rooms.

4. Why sharing the accommodation?

Holy Convocation provides a mean for excellent fellowship. These informal times will help encouraging one another.

5. What about food/ is food also provided?

Food is predominantly Indian. The breakfast will be continental but lunch and dinner are predominantly Indian. Please let the volunteers know.

6. What about parking?

Parking is provided in the hotel parking lot and is free.

7. Is there pick-up service for people who do not come by car?
